JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.29 dated 10.02.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, a stamp vendor, sold stamp papers in question to Paramjit Singh after due entry in the record. The misuse of the paper, if any, is attributable to co-accused Paramjit Singh. The matter stands compromised between the parties. Co-accused Bhupinder Singh, who is the beneficiary, has been admitted to bail. The challan stands presented in the matter. The petitioner is in custody since 07.11.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner issued the stamp papers in favour of co-accused Paramjit Singh without properly stamping them.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the challan stands presented, the parties have entered into compromise and co-accused Bhupinder Singh stands admitted to bail so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
