ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.145 dated 08.07.2017 under Sections 323/342/506/355/365/148/149 IPC , registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per allegations in the FIR, the injury attributed to the petitioner has been found to be simple in nature in the MLR of complainant. He further contends that the complainant has received five injuries, out of which only one on his right hand, has been found to be grievous. Five persons have been named in the FIR, which includes two sons of the petitioner and his wife.

This Court by the order dated 17.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Balraj Singh, states that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 17.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
