The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.134 dated 14.04.2015, under Sections 302, 34, 120-B, 476 of IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequent to passing of order by the trial Court, dismissing the bail application on 04.10.2016, some of prosecution witnesses have been examined including the complainant, who as per his version, is stated to have not supported the prosecution version.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, in case, the petitioner files an application for grant of bail on fresh ground, the trial Court will pass an order in accordance with law.
