This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 68 dated 14.08.2015, under Sections 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Maloud, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the prosecutrix has stood by her statement and none of the witnesses has been examined to date.

Faced with this, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and makes request for a direction to the trial Court for expeditious trial.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

It appears to this Court that last statement recorded was in the year 2016 and it seems that no effort has been made to conclude the trial thereafter.

Therefore, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

With above direction, the petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
