Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.160 dated 18.03.2016 under Sections 341, 365, 379B, 506, 120B and 201 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Satish Kumar, states that in the case in hand, trial is at the verge of completion and except the official witnesses, all the witnesses have been examined. He further states that out of total 17 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 14 witnesses have already been examined. The case is now fixed for 17.11.2017.

The case being at advance stage of trial, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
