SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.82 dated 15th June, 2017, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar (Punjab).

Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that the cheques relied upon by the complainant were not even filled up by his client in his own handwriting and that his client is ready to give his sample signatures and test handwriting for that purpose, and is also otherwise willing to join the investigation.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking and the fact that there is no material/document on record to show cash delivery in favour of the petitioner, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Area Magistrate concerned, subject to appropriate terms and conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
