Petitioner-Gurmeet has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.117 dated 28.06.2016, registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 302 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner is named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed armed with *binda*. Statement of Gomti has also been recorded before the trial Court wherein she stated that the present petitioner gave *binda* blow to her.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that the present petitioner has taken active participation in the commission of offence and trial is going on, no ground is made out to grant the benefit of bail to the accused.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 12.07.2016, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if necessary. Concerned Investigating Officer/Station House Officer is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before learned trial Court at the earliest i.e. on next two-three dates.
