Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.178 dated 26.04.2009 under Sections 379/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

This Court vide order dated 04.08.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 04.08.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Rashpal Singh, has stated that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. He further states that even the matter has also been compromised between the parties.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
