Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 175 dated 12.7.2017, under Sections 323, 328 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the controversy revolves around the differences between husband and wife and now both the parties have settled their dispute amicably.

Learned counsel representing the complainant fairly conceded at Bar that the parties have entered into compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 12.7.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Having considered the above facts and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 12.7.2017; matter has been settled between both the partners of life;

no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody and decision of the case still to take some time, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Panipat.

The petition stands allowed.
