Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 606 dated 19.07.2017, under Sections 354, 354-B and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Jhajjar.

It is reiterated that the petitioner and the complainant are neighbours and the petitioner has been falsely implicated merely due to a minor dispute which had arisen amongst them in the parking area. It is urged that none of the offences as alleged are made out against the petitioner. Moreover, he has joined investigation subsequently in compliance with order dated 04.08.2017.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to interim order passed by this Court and his custodial interrogation is not required. No recovery is to be effected from him.

There is no allegation that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 04.08.2017, is made absolute.
