Heard.

It comes out that the main injury i.e. *datar* blow on the left leg, which is found grievous in nature was attributed to the present petitioner.

It being so, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary and the weapon is also required to be recovered. Therefore, the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is dismissed.
