JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of impugned order dated 24.01.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Tarn Taran whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person.

On 30.01.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the present FIR was registered on the basis of secret information allegedly received by Inspector Inderjit Singh. The petitioner was neither present on the spot nor he ever was served before passing of the order dated 24.01.2014, whereby, he was declared a proclaimed person. He further refers to Annexure P-3 to contend that subsequently, petitioner has been falsely implicated in the these two FIRs wherein the petitioner had

been admitted to bail. The factum of present FIR was not brought to the knowledge of this Court while dealing with the petition by the prosecution.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel, in the Court.

Meanwhile, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the competent Court within ten days from today, he be admitted to bail, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.

Further proceedings before the trial Court shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

Post again on 16.03.2017.”

It is submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 30.01.2017, the petitioner has surrendered and furnished bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

In view of above, the order dated 30.01.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.
