Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No.1-complainant, is taken on record.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mohinder Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Gurugram, filed in court today on behalf of respondent No.2-State of Haryana, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.1-complainant states that the matter has been compromised between the parties and it is because of interim order dated 04.08.2017 whereby further

proceedings before the trial Court were stayed, the application seeking compounding of the offence could not be moved. Respondent-complainant has filed a complaint under Sections 403, 406, 420, 468, 471, 506 IPC. The case is now fixed for 27.09.2017 before the trial Court.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and because of interim order, the complainant could not move an appropriate application, present petition has been rendered infructuous at this stage enabling the party to move appropriate application before the trial Court.

Disposed of as infructuous.

It is made clear that in case the matter is not compromised, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive this petition.
