Petitioner-Balvir Kaur has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 05.12.2016 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Bathinda in CRA No.1117 of 2016, arising from the complaint case No.999 of 2014, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

However, none has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 despite service.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings before learned Appellate Court; her bail was cancelled

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and warrants of arrests were issued against her. However, there is only one absence i.e. on 05.12.2016 by the petitioner-appellant before the Appellate Court.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 30.01.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before learned Appellate Court and has been released on interim bail, as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above facts and in view of the facts that decision of the appeal will take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by sending or keeping the petitioner into custody till decision of the appeal, this petition is allowed by making the interim order dated 30.01.2017 as absolute.
