ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.209 dated 16.06.2017, under Sections 148/149/323/452/506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between neighbours and only simple injuries have been caused and now the matter has been resolved with the intervention of respectables.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of Addl.Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhajjar dated 22.08.017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between neighbours and only simple injuries have been caused and now the matter has been resolved with the intervention of respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.209 dated 16.06.2017, under Sections 148/149/323/452/506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
