Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

During the course of hearing, when a specific question regarding jurisdiction was put to learned counsel for the petitioners, he has fairly admitted that the respondents as arrayed in the petition are residing in Uttar Pradesh and the petitioners are residing in House No.299, Village Dharva, U.T. Chandigarh. But this fact was got verified through Ms. Ashima Mor, learned APP for U.T. Chandigarh, who after instructions of HC Rajesh Kumar, Police Post Dariya, U.T. Chandigarh has submitted that the petitioners are not residing at the given address.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.
