Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.43 dated 24.07.2016, under Sections 323 and 506 IPC (later on added Sections 498-A and 406 IPC), registered at Women Police Station, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre of this Court and as per the report dated 20.12.2016 of the Mediator, the matter has been compromised between the parties, vide compromise/settlement dated 14.12.2016.

In view of the above-said fact, order dated 24.08.2016, passed

petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
