Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gursimranjit Singh from Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala has made statement that all the prosecution evidence has been examined but learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his instructions there is no Presiding Officer of the rank of District & Sessions Judge/Additional District & Sessions Judge in Barnala as on date. However, the same is refuted by learned State counsel who submits that an officer has been posted who has taken over the charge and the matter is now fixed for 06.09.2017.

In the light of this inordinate delay that has crept in due to such a situation, necessary directions are issued to the present trial Court to ensure expediting the final disposal by giving short dates each not spanning more than a week by any means.

In the light of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client wishes to withdraw the present petition.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
