Heard.

The petitioners are stated to have got married against wishes of family of petitioner No.2-Neha, as such they are seeking protection against the parents and brother of petitioner No.2.

At this stage respondents No.4 to 6, parents and brother of petitioner No.2 have appeared and at their asking they have been allowed to meet petitioner No.2 in the Court. However, petitioner No.2 states that she wants to accompany her husband-petitioner No.1 and is not ready to return to her parental house.

Respondents No.4 to 6 along with their counsel Sh. Deshpreet

Singh, Advocate state that they have neither given any threats to the petitioners as alleged nor would they do so.
