ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 12.06.2017 under Sections 307/324/323/34 IPC (Section 307 IPC deleted vide DDR No.18 dated 13.07.2017 and Section 326 IPC has been added), registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the thumb of left hand of the complainant and the petitioner himself suffered injury on his right forearm. The petitioner is 75 years of age.

This Court, by the order dated 04.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 04.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
