This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for regular bail in FIR No.RCCHG2014S0007 dated 29.08.2014, under Sections 302, 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Special Crime Branch, CBI, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been arrested on 29.06.2015 and is in jail since then. He further submits that the statement of the deceased-Kulwant Singh has been recorded.

Since the evidence has been recorded and looking to the role attributed to the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Hence, I make the following order:-

**ORDER**

(i) CRM-M-28649 of 2017 is allowed.

- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es)/victim.
- (iv) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the Court below, if he possesses the same.
- (v) In case of violation, the liberty is reserved to apply for cancellation of bail.
