SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for regular of the petitioners in FIR No. 225 dated 23.9.2016 under Sections 306/325/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that main dispute was amongst two neighbours and the petitioners were since working as daily wagers, they are not interested in any type of litigation amongst the neighbours. More so, they are in custody since 23.9.2016 and their co-accused Sarabjit Singh @ Kala Mistri has already been granted bail by this Court. Decision of the case still to take some time, so the petitioners be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate contended that the petitioners are in custody since 26.9.2016, however, he opposed the prayer for release of the petitioners on bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel

for the parties and the facts that the petitioners are in custody since 26.9.2016 and the trial of the case is still to take some more time to conclude; so, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
