This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 104 dated 28.10.2016, under Sections 376(2)(n) and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Women Police Station, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 27.06.2017. In fact, after registration of the FIR, the petitioner has got married to the complainant on 02.11.2016. It is also submitted that the complainant has been summoned on five occasions but she has not come forward to get her statement recorded so far.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. She opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner but she is not able to dispute the fact that the complainant is not coming forth to get her statement recorded

despite being summoned on five occasions.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the paper book.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2017; the trial is likely to take some time to conclude and moreover the parties have got married, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
