The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 133, dated 31.12.2016, under Sections 365, 342, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and even the injuries attributed to the co-accused are simple in nature and are on non-vital parts of the body. He further states that co-accused Deepa Singh @ Sukhdeep Singh has already been extended the benefit of ad-interim bail by this Court in CRM No. M-27047 of 2017.

This Court, vide order dated 08.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
