Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 10.1.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that Archana daughter of Shiv Kumar has got married with the petitioner by concealing various facts. It has been alleged that Archana, respondent no.5, is elder to the petitioner in age but she did not disclose this fact to him. She has also concealed the fact that she was already married, before performing marriage with the petitioner. Therefore, she has committed a fraud while concealing the factum of her earlier marriage as well as her age.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the representation dated 10.1.2017 (Annexure P-1), this Court finds that it

is a purely a matrimonial dispute and this Court cannot pass any order or issue any direction to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in mechanical manner, more particularly in proceedings under Section 482 CrPC.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
