LISA GILL, J. (Oral)

It is contended that the petitioners are being threatened and harassed at the hands of respondents no. 4 to 13, because FIR No. 20, dated 09.03.2017, under Sections 366, 120-B IPC was registered against respondent no.4 and his relatives. Respondent no.4 had enticed the daughter of petitioner no.1 and illegally got married to her, even though he was earlier married. It is submitted that the petitioners are now being threatened to withdraw the above said case failing which they will be implicated in some criminal case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly concedes that no specific instances of any threat meted out to the petitioners finds mention in the representation dated 30.7.2017 (Annexure P-4). Neither is the learned counsel able to spell out any specific instance before this Court today.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach the authorities with complete details and particulars of the instances of the threats etc. which may have been meted out to the petitioners in this regard.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
