The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case bearing No.56 of 2015 instituted/registered on 19.03.2015 under Section 3(X) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 354, 504, 506 of Indian Penal Code, pending before learned JMIC, Ferozepur.

By an order dated 08.08.2017, notice of motion was issued in the matter and the petitioner herein was allowed interim bail, with the direction to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and furnish the personal bond and surety to its satisfaction.

As per office report, service is complete, however there is no

appearance on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has appeared before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds on 30.11.2017. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

In view of the fact that, pursuant to the order dated 08.08.2017 passed by this court granting interim bail, the petitioner herein has appeared before the trial court and furnished the bail bonds, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.08.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
