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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

These are the petitions filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by both the parties seeking quashing of FIR No.0118 dated 10.06.2017 registered under Sections 307, 148 & 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Section 325 and 34 IPC added later on and Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 307 IPC deleted later on) and cross case bearing general dairy No.004 dated 11.06.2017 registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 380, 295, 148, 149 IPC (Section 380, 295, 323, 427 IPC

deleted later on) at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for rival parties submit that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 08.08.2017 in both the petitions asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and without any threat, coercion and undue influence. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners in both the petitions. Looking to the nature of the offences I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-28757 OF 2017 & CRL. MISC. No.28589 OF 2017 are allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.0118 dated 10.06.2017 and cross case bearing general dairy No.004 dated 11.06.2017 at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rura, are quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
