ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for regular bail in case FIR No. 91 dated 24.6.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is 63 years old person and as per the allegations in FIR, no specific injury is attributed to him. He has also referred to MLR of the injured person to submit that all the injuries are simple in nature as no fracture was found.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no opinion of the doctor with regard to declaring any of the injuries as dangerous to life.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhvinder Singh, submits that it is the petitioner only who has been arrested and none of the other co-accused has been arrested so far.

Considering the aforesaid fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 26.6.2017 and he is no more required for further investigation, without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, it is made clear that in case during the pendency of the petitioner, petitioner is involved in any other case, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail.
