The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.102 dated 28.05.2017, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 10.06.2017. He further submits that co-accused, namely, Meera, daughter of the petitioner has been granted regular bail, vide order dated 05.09.2017 passed in CRM-M-31986-2017. He also submitted that co-accused, namely, Smt. Raj Bala, wife of the petitioner, has been granted regular bail by the Sessions Court on 16.08.2017 and the other co-accused Ram Mehar i.e. brother of the petitioner has also been granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Judge. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact, there was a matrimonial discord between the daughter of the petitioner, namely, Meera and her husband-Anil, who has allegedly committed suicide by writing a suicide note, original of which, has been handed over to the police. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation of abatement in the suicide note for the petitioner is levelled and challan has already been presented and therefore, the petitioner is no more

required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rajvinder Singh, has not disputed the factual assertions, however, opposed the bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
