**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner in case FIR No. 0149 dated 4.6.2017 under Sections 379-B and 382 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Dakha District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the version given in the FIR, six boys having muffled faces came on three motor cycle and has taken away cash, mobile phone etc. He further submits that later on, petitioner and the co-accused were named by the complainant- Sushil Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is in judicial lock up since 7.6.2017 and nothing has been recovered from him whereas in another two FIRs he has been granted bail; the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nazar Singh, has opposed the concession of bail on the ground that petitioner has made a disclosure statement.

Keeping in view the above fact and without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
