Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No.44 dated 17.04.2017, under Sections 326/324/34 IPC, Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar, was registered for the injuries caused on the person of the petitioner-Lovedeep Singh. He further states that let the police may be directed to investigate the case in a fair manner.

The prayer made in the petition is not sustainable as the FIR in question was registered on 17.04.2017. Therefore, no interference is warranted at this stage, but at the same time, it is expected that the police must conduct fair investigation.

With the aforesaid observations, present petition stands disposed of.
