In this petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.113, dated 03.04.2013, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that the petitioner entered into an agreement with the complainant on the basis of attorney given to him by Balraj Singh while impersonating as Madan Mohan, who is the original land owner. He is in custody since 12.10.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions,

submits that the petitioner is involved in three other FIRs i.e. FIR No.239 dated 17.06.2013 registered under Sections 406, 420, 419, 467, 468, 506 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ganour; FIR No.529 dated 11.10.2015 registered under Section 174-A IPC, Police Station Ganour; FIR No.267 dated 11.05.2015 registered under Section 174-A IPC, at Police Station City Sonapat and he had been declared a proclaimed offender.

Heard.

Considering the facts that the petitioner is deliberately avoiding the process of Court for such a number of years and he is a habitual offender, no case for bail is made out.

Dismissed.
