Petitioner-Ravinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53 dated 28.04.2017, registered at Police Station Phul, District Bathinda, under Sections 308 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that it is a case of version and cross-version and it is yet to be determined by the trial Court on the basis of

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evidence as to who is the aggressor party. The petitioner has also received three injuries on his head. The injury attributed to the petitioner is on the head of Bahadur Singh with *Kasoli*, which has been declared grievous in nature. No injury has been declared dangerous to life.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 09.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 09.08.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
