The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 64 dated 27.12.2016, under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he was armed with a Datar and while leaving the place of occurrence, he along with other accused had raised Lalkara. The gun shot injuries, which resulted into the death of the deceased, are attributed to two other accused, namely, Kanwal Narayan Singh @ JP and Sucha Singh. Learned counsel further contends that no injury whatsoever is alleged to have been caused by the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 08 months

since his arrest on 20.02.2017.

Heard.

The petitioner is stated to have only raised Lalkara along with other accused while leaving the place of occurrence. No injury is attributed to him. He is in custody for over 08 months. It would be appropriate if the petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Balraj Singh @ Boori is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
