Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to transfer the case in FIR No.101 dated 24.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 379/34 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, from District Ludhiana (State of Punjab) to District Fatehabad (State of Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the aforesaid FIR was registered at the instance of the petitioner and when the investigation in the matter was in process, the accused have started threatening and harassing the petitioner for lodging the FIR against them. During the course of investigation, the petitioner had gone to Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana where the FIR was registered and when he was going back, the accused assaulted him. However, he was saved. The petitioner prayed for protection in the case. He states that

highlighting the requirement of protection, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, but no action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Without making any final observation in the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the contents of representation dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
