Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No.211 dated 10.08.2016, registered at Police Station City Khanna, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 306 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the role of the present petitioner is that she has illicit relationship with the husband of the deceased. He further submits the petitioner is in custody since 31.08.2016 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so, she be released on bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that in the present case, charges have been framed on 02.02.2017 and 14 witnesses have to be examined.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during the pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
