The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.44 dated 29.05.2017 registered under Sections 380, 409, 411 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Behram, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that 240 bags of wheat were seized from the petitioner during investigation.

In my opinion, there is no point in putting the petitioner behind the bars since the trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:
