ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in complaint Case No.RBT-103, Date of Institution-15.06.2012/01.07.2013, titled 'Payre Lal Vs. Mulkh Raj etc.', under Sections 302, 218, 167, 195, 120-B of the IPC, Police Station Sadar Tohana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the complaint are that the petitioner along with other accused including Dinesh, Manjeet, Sammat hatched a conspiracy with Naresh Ranga murder Rajender, who is the son of the complainant. Learned counsel further contends that the son of the complainant had consumed Aluminum Phosphide, which was also the cause of his death. He further contends that FIR No. 59, dated 04.03.2010, under Sections 363, 366 IPC had been registered against the deceased

for having enticed the daughter of one Hawa Singh. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has already been in custody for over seven months ever since the date of his arrest on 11.01.2017. He further contends that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Dinesh has been granted regular bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M No. 7836 of 2017, decided on 18.05.2017, after being in custody for three months. This Court had also granted bail to co-accused Sammat in CRM-M-19281-2017 by the order dated 24.07.2017. Therefore, as similarly situated co-accused, namely, Dinesh has been granted regular bail and the petitioner has been in custody for over seven months, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Suba is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
