Custody certificate has been filed today in the Court
and the same is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439
the Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No. 169 dated 03.07.2015
registered under Section 302, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC at
Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Contends that the petitioner is neither named in the
FIR nor any injury has been attributed to him. It is further contended
that the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR. He is in custody
since 01.02.2017. Similarly, situated co-accused Binder Singh, Piara
Singh and Chanan Singh have already been admitted to bail by this

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any injury has been attributed to him; he is in custody since 01.02.2017; out of 14 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far, therefore, it can be safely inferred that the completion of trial will take a long time so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
