Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.132 dated 04.06.2014 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1), order dated 09.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti vide which the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed persons and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 02.06.2017 (Annexure P-2).

On 09.08.2017, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he restricts his prayer qua the impugned order dated 09.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti, whereby the petitioners were declared as proclaimed persons. He states

that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law.

In view of above, the prayer of the petitioners is restricted only qua the impugned order dated 09.11.2015 and their prayer for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise dated 02.06.2017 is declined at this stage.

Meanwhile, in case, the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within a week from today, they shall be admitted on bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Charan Singh, states that pursuant to the order dated 09.08.2017 passed by this Court, petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and they have been admitted on bail.

In view of above, present petition no more survives and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
