SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for regular bail of the petitioner in FIR No. 25 dated 25.6.2017 under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120B IPC, registered at Police Station Airport, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on the allegations that clearance certificate was fabricated one; he is in custody since 25.6.2017 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Malkiat Singh contended that clearance certificate is found to be genuine and not fabricated as was the initial version. He affirmed that the petitioner is in custody since 25.6.2017 but he opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 25.6.2017; decision of the case still to take some more time; no useful purpose would

be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Amritsar.

The petition stands allowed.
