ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of DDR No.30 dated 04.07.2017 under Sections 324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) , on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-4) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the parties are neighbours and DDR is an offshoot of a monetary dispute which has now been resolved.

This Court by the order dated 10.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul, has

sent his report dated 30.08.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties, who are neighbours and the matter has now been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and cross case recorded vide DDR No.30 dated 04.07.2017 under Sections 324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
