The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.77 dated 07.04.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 302 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no injuries are attributed to the petitioners who are ladies and both injuries on the deceased are attributed to co-accused Kulwant and Bunty. He further states that 12 accused have been named in the FIR, although the deceased has received only two injuries. The petitioners are in custody for over 4 months.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are in custody for over 4 months,

no injury is attributed to them and the deceased has suffered only two injuries which are attributed to other accused, I deem it to be a fit case to grant them the concession of regular bail. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
