This petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner – Karamvir Singh in case FIR No.92 dated 17.6.2015, under Sections 420/120-B/465/468/471 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that petitioner was arrested in this case on 19.1.2016 and since then he is in custody in this case. He further submits that challan in this case has already been presented before the learned trial Court and the case is now fixed for recording of prosecution evidence.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the copy of an order dated 7.9.2016 passed by Co-

ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-10742 of 2016 vide which regular bail was granted to the co-accused namely Sandeep Goyal of the present petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that case of the present petitioner and of above-said co-accused – Sandeep Goyal is on the same footing. The trial of case will take some time for its disposal.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Magistrate, Bathinda.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
