INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Surinder Kumr and Ashok Kumar, have filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.3; for issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondent No.4 and further for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide at least 10 days time while serving notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the petitioners are required in any complaint or inquiry, if any, registered against them.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the extent that the official respondents may be directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-9) and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if a direction has been issued to the official respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner.

In view of above, Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 20.08.2016 (Annexure P-9) within 2 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Disposed of with the aforesaid direction.
