This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.75, dated 07.07.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 21.08.2017, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation.

On 22.09.2017, the learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the recovery of fire arm weapon is yet to be effected from petitioner No.2- Jagsir Singh @ Jagga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gandhoor Singh, submits that though, petitioner No.1 Kulwinder Singh @ Kindi has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. However, petitioner No.2 Jagsir Singh @ Jagga is not cooperating with the investigating agency and the recovery of fire arm weapon and Innova car is yet to be effected.

Accordingly, the present petition qua petitioner No.2-Jagsir Singh @ Jagga is dismissed and the order dated 21.08.2017, granting interim bail to petitioner No.1 Kulwinder Singh @ Kindi, is made absolute.
