The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.239 dated 26.07.2017, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 10.08.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the petitioner will file an undertaking that he would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to give undertaking on affidavit as stated above, I am inclined to make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Interim order dated 10.08.2017 is made absolute.
- (ii) The CRL. MISC. No.M-29096 of 2017 is allowed, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from today that he will not commit any type of offence again and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station as aforesaid
