Quashing of FIR No. 38 dated 30.04.2011 under Sections 498-A/506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Tehsil Balata, District Gurdaspur, is being sought on the basis of compromise dated 09.12.2015 (Annexure P/2).

Respondent No. 3 got married to petitioner No.1. Due to temperamental differences, both the parties could not live together as husband and wife. The relationship between them became strained and thereafter, the F.I.R was registered against the petitioners on account of harassment and humiliation caused on the pretext of bringing less dowry.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise dated 09.12.2015 (Annexure P/2). In compliance of order dated 27.8.2016, report dated 18.10.2016 of Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Batala, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 18.10.2016 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 38 dated 30.04.2011 under Sections 498-A/506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Tehsil Balata, District Gurdaspur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
