Petitioner-Krishan Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.40 dated 19.02.2017, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, complainant-Amandeep Singh met the present petitioner, who induced him to give ₹22,50,000/- for getting sponsor visa from Australia. It is also mentioned in the FIR that ₹7,50,000/- were given in cash and then ₹2,50,000/- were paid out of which ₹1,22,000/- were deposited in the account of the petitioner. However, neither any such visa was given nor money was returned to the complainant.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
